The Master of Marine Science is course offered jointly by the University of Milano-Bicocca, Italy and The Maldives National University. The course provides with the skills to conceive solutions and develop strategies to solve marine and coastal areas problematic issues, with particular regard to study and analysis of a) natural processes and related risks, with reference to the marine ecosystem (chemical, biological, ecological, earth sciences fields); b) human interaction in the marine system (socio-economic and legal fields), for a policy of sustainable management and protection from anthropogenic risks in oceanic and coastal environment.

Mode of Delivery

After completion of the first common teachings, students can choose among three different tracks: ENVIRONMENT, BIO-ECOLOGY and HUMAN GEOGRAPHY. Lessons will be taught in English by world-class scientist and researchers.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Bachelor's Degree at MNQF level 7 OR level 8 in marine sciences or a related field*

Graduates with a high competence level but whose background is not entirely consistent with the requirements may be admitted to the assessment interview. The selection committee will evaluate education related experience of the candidates in considering admission to the program

Language requirements

Unless undergraduate studies were in English medium, an applicant must have proficiency in English language (6.0 in IELTS academic module or a C grade in the Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English (CAE) or equivalent) or pass in a language exam administered by the university.
