

CENTRE FOR MARITIME STUDIES

The establishment of a Maritime Training Centre in the Maldives was made possible in 1987 through the ratification of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers (STCW). This Centre, overseen by the Ministry of Transport, had the important task of educating and training Maldivian seafarers to meet the rigorous international standards set by the STCW convention.

In 1995, recognizing the need for more space, the Maritime Training Centre relocated to its current location in Villimale'. The Centre underwent further transformations in 1999 with the establishment of the Maldives College of Higher Education (MCHE), leading to its renaming as the Centre for Maritime Studies.

In 2011, significant changes occurred when the MCHE transitioned into a university. As a result, the Centre for Maritime Studies was elevated to an institute within The Maldives National University.

Today, the Centre for Maritime Studies offers accredited courses aligned with the STCW convention, sanctioned by the Ministry of Transport and Civil Aviation. It remains dedicated to ensuring that Maldivian seafarers receive training that meets international standards.

SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

Established in October 2018, the School of Medicine (SM) at The Maldives National University stands as the sole medical school within the Maldives. Currently, the School of Medicine provides an undergraduate medical degree program, known as Doctor of Medicine (MD), which spans over a period of 5 years. The curriculum implemented for this program follows that of Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM), Malaysia's National University, with technical guidance provided by UKM.

Prominent clinicians from reputable institutions such as Indira Gandhi Memorial Hospital (IGMH), ADK Hospital, Kulhudhuffushi Regional Hospital, and Senahiya Military Hospital actively participate in teaching the clinical aspects of the program. Since its inception, the School of Medicine has successfully recruited and enrolled five batches of students, with the earliest batch expected to graduate in 2024.

- 7. To aid postgraduate research students that centres to which they belong are unable to provide.



MNU Book Writing Grants

The introduction of book writing grants reflects MNU's commitment to fostering a culture of creativity, intellectual growth, and knowledge sharing. By providing financial assistance, MNU enables talented individuals to pursue their literary ambitions, explore their ideas, and contribute to the literary landscape.

The availability of book writing grants not only benefits the individual writers but also enriches the academic environment at MNU. By supporting the creation and publication of books, MNU demonstrates its commitment to promoting literacy, nurturing talent, and advancing intellectual pursuits within its academic community.

MNU Book Publishing Grants

The MNU book publishing grant, in accordance with the University Act, has the objective of disseminating the findings of scientific investigations, research, and related endeavors to contribute to the advancement of both the national and international community.

Under the university's book publishing program, there are three methods available for publishing books under the university's name. The first approach involves the author covering all expenses associated with publishing the book, while retaining the copyright.

The second option is for the university to fund the publication process. In this scenario, the university provides financial support for the publication, and the author retains the copyright.

The third alternative is for the university to acquire books from authors that already possess copyrights. This allows the university to expand its collection of published works while respecting the author's rights and intellectual property.


