

## **Examination Hall Rules**

---

- Candidates are allowed to take the following materials into the exam hall:
  - National ID card/passport
  - Exam registration slip issued by the respective Council.
  - Exam fee payment receipt
  - A pen (blue or black)
  - A bottle of water (without any labels).
- All other materials including bags, purse, wallets, food and drinks, mobile phones, smart watches, and any interactive and storage devices, must be deposited as directed by the invigilator. Mobile phones must be switched off or set to silent mode and the vibration and any alarms must also be switched off, before putting them away.
- Please show your ID card/passport, exam registration slip and payment receipt to the invigilator when you enter the exam hall. The registration slip and payment receipt should be handed to the invigilator and collected after the exam.
- Check your PC number and ensure that you sit at the allocated computer, identifiable through the PC number affixed to the computer.
- **Cheating or copying is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification of the candidate from the exam.** Hence, please ensure that you strictly adhere to the following rules during the exam:
  - **DO NOT** browse through internet sites on the computer.
  - **DO NOT** keep unauthorized materials in your possession.
  - **DO NOT** talk or communicate with other candidates in any way.
- Candidates who go out of the exam hall unaccompanied by an invigilator will not be allowed to resume the exam, upon returning.
- Silence **MUST** be maintained in the exam hall, at all times.
- Candidates are **NOT** allowed to remove exam materials from the exam hall.
