TERMS OF REFERENCE

Consultancy Services for Quality Management System

(ISO 9001:2015) at Center for Maritime Studies, The Maldives National University

This TOR is in reference to announcement number: 153-CMS/IUL/2025/003

A. Background

The Centre for Maritime Studies (CMS), The Maldives National University (MNU), is the leading institution in the Maldives dedicated to providing education and training in the maritime and shipping industry. Established in 1987, CMS has been the nation's foremost provider of maritime education and training for over three decades.

The Centre offers a wide range of **STCW**, **IMO**, and specialized courses for **skippers**, **crew**, and **marine mechanics**, in accordance with the requirements of the **Ministry of Transport and Civil Aviation**.

CMS is accredited under ISO 9001:2015, ensuring compliance with STCW Regulation I/8 – Quality Standards, certified by an IACS-class Certification Body. The Centre now intends to transfer its ISO 9001:2015 certification from DNV to Bureau Veritas (BV) as part of its commitment to maintaining international quality standards and continuous improvement.

B. Scope of Work

The selected consultant/firm will be responsible for:

- Reviewing and updating existing ISO 9001:2015 documentation and systems.
- Enhancing the Quality Manual, procedures, and supporting forms.
- Conducting internal and pre-certification audits.
- Facilitating certification and surveillance processes with relevant certification bodies.
- Providing advisory support and training to CMS staff as required.



C. Expected Outputs and Deliverables

The selected consultant or firm is expected to review, update, and strengthen the existing ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System (QMS) at CMS and facilitate the Centre's transition of certification from DNV to Bureau Veritas (BV).

The key expected outputs and deliverables include:

- 1. **Inception Report and Work Plan** outlining methodology, timeline, and responsibilities.
- 2. **Gap Analysis Report** identifying areas requiring improvement in the current QMS.
- 3. Revised QMS Documentation updated Quality Manual, procedures, process maps, forms, and related records.
- 4. **Training and Awareness Sessions** for CMS management and staff on updated QMS procedures and ISO 9001:2015 requirements.
- 5. **Internal Audit and Management Review** assistance in conducting internal audits and management review meetings, with corresponding reports.
- 6. **Support for External (Recertification) Audit** facilitation during the transition and recertification audit process with **BV**.
- 7. **Final Completion Report** summarizing activities undertaken, corrective actions, and recommendations for continual improvement.

All deliverables must be submitted in both **digital and printed formats**, meeting the standards and timelines agreed upon in the contract.

E. Price and Duration

- Initial evaluation points will be awarded based on the first-year pricing.
- Completion period for the recertification deliverables is (1) month.
- The contract will initially be made for one (1) year, and bidders may include proposed prices for Year 2 and Year 3. Based on satisfactory performance, the contract may be extended for up to three (3) years, until the next recertification cycle.

F. Minimum Qualifications

Interested consultants/firms must meet the following criteria:

- Proven experience in implementing and maintaining ISO 9001:2015 QMS in educational or public institutions.
- At least one ISO 9001 Lead Auditor or Lead Implementer (CQI–IRCA or PECB certified) on the project team.
- Demonstrated capacity to deliver similar consultancy services in the Maldives or regionally.
- Strong understanding of management systems, documentation, and audit processes.

G. Recommended Documents for Submission

Applicants are encouraged to include the following documents in their bid package:

- 1. Company Profile outlining relevant experience and expertise.
- 2. **Details of Project Team** including qualifications, certifications, and roles.
- 3. Copies of ISO 9001 Lead Auditor/Implementer Certifications.
- 4. **Past Project References** with contact details of clients (preferably similar institutions).
- 5. **Proposed Work Plan and Methodology** for ISO 9001:2015 implementation and support.
- 6. Financial Proposal with itemized costs and payment terms.
- 7. Copy of Business Registration Certificate.
- 8. Tax Clearance and GST Registration Documents.



H. Evaluation Criteria
